C.B. NO. 21-295

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 3, 6, 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 21-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-55, 21-77, 21-94, 21-116, 21-147, and 21-171 to appropriate \$2,503,500 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, in order to provide supplemental funding for the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in 16

Section 5. Section 12 of Public Law No. 21-42, as amended by
Public Laws Nos. 21-55, 21-77, 21-94, 21-116 and 21-147 is hereby

11	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
12	of September 30, 2020; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds
13	appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not
14	lapse."
15	Section 6. This act shall become law upon approval by the
16	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
17 18	becoming law without such approval.
