A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-64, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-81, 19-97, 19-120, 19-137, 20-29, 20-86, 20-119, 21-31 and 21-160, by amending sections 1 and 2 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the state of Kosrae, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-64, as amended 1 by Public Laws Nos. 19-81, 19-97, 19-120, 19-137 and 20-29, is 2 3 hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Purpose. The sum of \$3,050,000, or so much 4 thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from 5 6 the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia 7 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs 8 9 in the states of Kosrae and Pohnpei. The funds 10 appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as 11 follows: (1) state of Kosrae \$ 300,000 12 13 (a) Road maintenance -0-14 (b) Fishing projects -0-(c) Micronesian Baseball Classic 2017

1	Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-64, as amended
2	by Public Laws Nos. 19-81, 19-97, 20-86, 20-119, 21-31 and
3	21-160, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
4	"Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
5	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
6	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
7	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
8	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
9	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
10	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
11	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
12	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
13	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
14	under section 1 of this act shall be the President of
15	the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
16	PROVIDED THAT, the funds appropriated under subsections
17	l(d) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
18	designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
19	subsections 1(e) to 1(n) of this act shall be the
20	Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee
21	of funds appropriated under subsections 1(2)(1)(a)-(o),
22	1(2)(2)(a), 1(2)(2)(c), 1(2)(4)(a)-(j) shall be the
23	Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of
24	funds appropriated under subsections 1(2)(2)(b),
25	1(2)(2)(d), 1(2)(2)(e) and 1(2)(2)(f) shall be the

1	Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
2	Communication and Infrastructure or his designee; the
3	allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
4	1(2)(2)(g), 1(2)(2)(h) and 1(2)(2)(l) shall be the
5	Pohnpei Utility Corporation; the allottee of funds
6	appropriated under subsection 1(2)(2)(m) shall be the
7	Secretary of the Department of Education or his
8	designee; the allottee of fund appropriated under
9	subsections $1(2)(4)(k)-(s)$ shall be the Governor of the
10	State of Pohnpei. The authority of the allottee to
11	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
12	September 30, 2022."
13	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
14	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
15	becoming law without such approval.
