A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate \$61,143,148 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this act is to 2 appropriate the sum of \$61,143,148 from the General Fund of the 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending 4 September 30, 2020, for the purpose of funding the operations of 5 all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of 6 Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and 7 contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development. The 8 National Government's share of the Amended Compact funds has been 9 reduced to zero; EXCEPT THAT; the National Government will retain 10 the Compact Sector Grant amount for COM-FSM and 10 percent of the 11 Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in the budget 12 for the Department of Education. Financial Management Act of 1979.

(b) The allottees shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sums appropriated.

1 Micronesia; (d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds shall be 2 3 the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia; (e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these 4 5 funds shall be the President of the Federated States of 6 Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following subsections 7 of sections 8 through 9 of this act: 8 (i) Sections 8(1)(f) and 8(13)(q) - the allottee 9 of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on 10 Compact Review and Planning; 11 (ii) Section 8(8)(a) - the allottee of these 12 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae; 13 (iii) Section 8(8)(b) - the allottee of these 14 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei; 15 (iv) Section 8(8)(c) - the allottee of these 16 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk; 17 (v) Section 8(8)(d) - the allottee of these funds 18 shall be the Governor of the state of Yap; 19 (vi) Section 8(11) - the allottee of these funds 20 shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of Micronesia; 21 (vii) Section 8(12) - the allottee of these funds 22 shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States of 23 Micronesia; (viii) Section 8(13)(a) - the allottee of these 24 25 funds shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;

1 (ix) Section 8(13)(d) through (g) - the allottee 2 of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the respective State 3 Supreme Court; 4 (x) Section 8(13)(h) - the allottee of these 5 funds shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the 6 Federated States of Micronesia 7 (xi) Section 9(1) - the allottee of these funds 8 shall be the President of the College of Micronesia-FSM; 9 (xii) Section 9(3)(b) - the allottee of these 10 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae; 11 (xiii) Section 9(3)(c) - the allottee of these 12 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei; 13 (xiv) Section 9(3)(d) - the allottee of these 14 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk; 15 (xv) Section 9(3)(e) - the allottee of these 16 funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap; 17 (3) Lapse date.
