PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-183

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 3, 6, 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 21-42, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-55, 21-77, 21-94, 21-116, 21-147, and 21-171 to appropriate \$2,503,500 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, in order to provide supplemental funding for the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 21-42, as amended by

The purpose of this act is to appropriate the 4 5 sum of \$75,979,075, from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year 6 7 ending September 30, 2020, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches of the National 8 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its 9 10 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and 11 contributions and Capital and Human Resources The National Government's share of the 12 Development. 13 Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT 14 THAT; the National Government will retain the Compact Sector Grant amount for COM-FSM and 10 percent of the 15 16 Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in 17 the budget for the Department of Education. 18	"Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and
19	Lapse Dates.
20	(1) General provisions.
21	(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
22	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
23	accordance with applicable law, including, but not
24	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
25	(b) The allottees shall be responsible for

1	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
2	necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
3	this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
4	of the sums appropriated.
5	(2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
6	appropriated by this act are as follows:
7	(a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds shall
8	be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;
9	(b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds shall
10	be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated States
11	of Micronesia;
12	(c) Section 4 — the allottee of these funds shall
13	be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
14	Federated States of Micronesia;
15	(d) Section 5 — the allottee of these funds shall
16	be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
17	Micronesia;
18	(e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
19	funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
20	Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
21	subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:
22	(i) Sections $8(1)(f)$ and $8(13)(q)$ — the
23	allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint
24	Committee on Compact Review and Planning;
25	(ii) Section 8(8)(a) - the allottee of these

1	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
2	(iii) Section $8(8)(b)$ — the allottee of these
3	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;
4	(iv) Section $8(8)(c)$ - the allottee of these
5	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;
6	(v) Section $8(8)(d)$ - the allottee of these
7	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;
8	(vi) Section $8(11)$ — the allottee of these
9	funds shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated
10	States of Micronesia;
11	(vii) Section $8(12)$ — the allottee of these
12	funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
13	Federated States of Micronesia;
14	(viii) Section $8(13)(a)$ — the allottee of these
15	funds shall be the President of the College of
16	Micronesia-FSM;
17	(ix) Section $8(13)(d)$ through (g) - the
18	allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of
19	the respective State Supreme Court;
20	(x) Section 8(13)(h) - the allottee of these
21	funds shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of
22	the Federated States of Micronesia;
23	(xi) Section $9(1)$ — the allottee of these
24	funds shall be the President of the College of
25	Micronesia-FSM;

1	(xii) Section $9(3)(b)$ — the allottee of these
2	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
3	(xiii) Section $9(3)(c)$ - the allottee of
4	these funds shall be the Governor of the state of
5	Pohnpei;
6	(xiv) Section $9(3)(d)$ - the allottee of
7	these funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;
8	(xv) Section $9(3)(e)$ - the allottee of
9	these funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;
10	(xvi) Section 9(11)(b) - the allottee of
11	these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
12	Federated States of Micronesia;
13	(xvii) Section 9(11)(f)- the allottee of
14	these funds shall be the Governor of the State of Chuuk;
15	(xviii) Section 8(13)(t) - the allottee of

24	these funds shall be the Secretary of the Department of
25	Transportation, Communications, and Infrastructure

1	(xxii) Section $9(11)(n)$ and $9(11)(o)$ - the
2	allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the
3	Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia.
4	(3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottees to
5	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
6	of September 30, 2020; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds
7	appropriated under section 9 of this act shall not
8	lapse."
9	Section 6. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
11	becoming law without such approval.
