AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-135, 20-146, 20-157, 20-179, 20-189, 21-06 and 21-40, by amending sections 2, 3 and 5 thereof, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Yap, Kosrae and Chuuk, and for other purposes.
