PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-77

AN ACT

To amend sections 1, 2, 3, 5, 8, 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 21-42, as amended by Public Law No. 21-55, to appropriate \$7,417,994 of additional funds from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, to provide supplemental funding for the operations of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, Office of Public Auditor, Grants, Subsidies and Contributions, and Capital and Human Resources Development, and to change the allottee of certain funds; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 21-42, as amended by

The purpose of this act is to appropriate the 5 sum of \$71,808,352 from the General Fund of the 6 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020, for the purpose of funding 7 the operations of all branches of the National 8 9 Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its 10 agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and 11 contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development. The National Government's share of the 12 Amended Compact funds has been reduced to zero; EXCEPT 13 14 THAT; the National Government will retain the Compact 15 Sector Grant amount for COM-FSM and 10 percent of the 16 Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in

2	Section 7. Section 12 of Public Law No. 21-42, as amended by
3	Public Law No. 21-55, is hereby further amended to read as
4	follows:
5	"Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and
6	Lapse Dates.
7	(1) General provisions.
8	(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
9	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
10	accordance with applicable law, including, but not
11	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
12	(b) The allottees shall be responsible for
13	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
14	necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
15	this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
16	of the sums appropriated.
17	(2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
18	appropriated by this act are as follows:

7	(x) Section $8(13)(h)$ - the allottee of these
8	funds shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of
9	the Federated States of Micronesia
10	(xi) Section $9(1)$ — the allottee of these
11	funds shall be the President of the College of
12	Micronesia-FSM;
13	(xii) Section $9(3)(b)$ — the allottee of these
14	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
15	(xiii) Section $9(3)(c)$ - the allottee of these
16	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;
17	(xiv) Section $9(3)(d)$ - the allottee of these
18	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;
19	(xv) Section $9(3)(e)$ — the allottee of these

8	Section 8. This act shall become law upon approval by the
9	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
