AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-135, 20-146, 20-157, 20-179 and 20-189, by amending section 5 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 20-135, 20-146, 20-179 and 20-189, is hereby

3 becoming law without such approval.

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
