Dear Speaker Simina:

I am transmitting the following Congressional Act, which I have signed into Public Law No. 21-110:

Congressional Act No. 21-106, entitled: "An ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-80, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-99, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 5 AND 6 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE AND ALLOTTEE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE PEOPLE OF YAP AND CHUUK STATES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

This Congressional Act is amending Public Law No. 21- 80 in the following manner: 1) Removing funding for Dredging and Transportation equipment; 2) Increase of \$20,000 for Contribution to State, Municipal and community activities, events and programs; and 3) New funding for Blue Lagoon Crusher Plant Subsidy/Operating Costs for \$50,000. 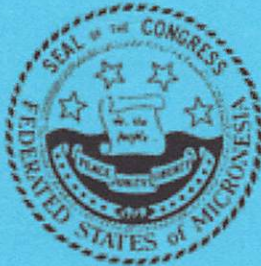

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 21-185, C.D.1

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 21-80, as amended by Public Law No. 21-99, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Yap and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 21-80, is hereby  
2 further amended to read as follows.

3       "Section 5. Of the \$4,200,000 appropriated under this act,  
4       \$1,820,000 shall be apportioned for public projects and  
5       social programs for the people of Chuuk State.

18 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-80, as amended by  
 19 Public Law No. 21-99, is hereby further amended to read as  
 20 follows:

21 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
 22 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
 23 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
 24 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
 25 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The



1 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
2 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
3 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no  
4 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
5 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
6 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
7 State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of  
8 funds appropriated under subsection 2(a) of this act  
9 shall be the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of funds  
10 appropriated under subsections 2(c) and 2(d) of this act  
11 shall be the President of the Federated States of  
12 Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of funds  
13 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be  
14 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or  
15 his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds  
16 appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act shall be  
17 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the  
18 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(2) of  
19 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or  
20 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
21 subsections 4(2) of this act shall be the Secretary of  
22 the Department of Transportation, Communications and  
23 Infrastructure, except that the allottee funds  
24 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(f) shall be the  
25 Pohnpei Port Authority (PPA); the allottee of funds

1           appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(1) and  
2           4(3)(m) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation  
3           Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under  
4           subsections 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the  
5           Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti; the allottee of funds  
6           appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(e), 4(3)(f)  
7           and 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the Meninkeder of  
8           Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
9           subsections 4(3)(h), 4(3)(i) and 4(3)(j) of this act  
10          shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and  
11          Social Affairs or his designee; the allottee of funds  
12          appropriated under subsection 4(3)(n) of this act shall  
13          be the Vice President of the Federated States of  
14          Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of the funds  
15          appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of  
16          this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his  
17          designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
18          subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island  
19          Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds  
20          appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be  
21          the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee  
22          of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this  
23          act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The  
24          authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated  
25          by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2022."

1           Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
