Dear Speaker Simina:

I am transmitting the following Act, which I signed into Public Law No. 21-115 with item veto as explained in this transmittal:

Congressional Act No. 21-110, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-178, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56 AND 21-102, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 4 AND 6 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE AND ALLOTTEE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE PEOPLE OF CHUUK STATE, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

I noted the changes in the funding of several public projects and social programs for the State of Pohnpei. Given that Congress has the discretion to appropriate funds and to change them if deemed necessary, I do not question the wisdom of the amendments.

However, with respect to two line items for Pohnpei-At-Large, the funding that was appropriated before was already allotted and spent for the intended projects. As such, any changes in the usage of funds under the circumstances are not allowed. Therefore, I have no choice but to item veto the amendments under 4(1)(q) and 4(1)(u) of this Act due to insufficient funding that is needed to accommodate these changes. Thank you.

FIFTH SPECIAL SESSION, 2020 CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 21-179, C.D.1

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56 and 21-102, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(ad) of this act and 4(2)(q) shall be the President of COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(ae) to 3(ak) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(al) of this act shall be the Secretary of the FSM Department of Education or his designee. allottee of funds appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under section 4(1) and subsection 4(3)(w) of this act shall be the Vice President of the

Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the
allottee of funds appropriated under subsections

4(3)(j) and 5(6)(a) of this act shall be the Secretary
of the Department of Transportation, Communications and
Infrastructure or his designee; The allottee of the
funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of
this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks
Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of

1	funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act
2	shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
3	designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
4	subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern
5	Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the
6	funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act
7	shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The
8	authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
9	by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2020."
10	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
11	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
