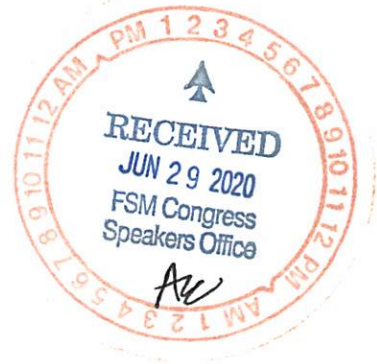

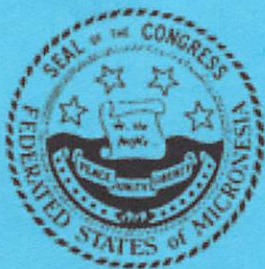

CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 21-220, C.D.1

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 21-80, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-99 and 21-110, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 21-80, is hereby
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 4. Of the \$4,200,000 appropriated under this
4 act, \$1,200,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
5 and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State.

8 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-80, as amended by
9 Public Laws Nos. 21-99 and 21-110, is hereby further amended to
10 read as follows:

11 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
12 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
13 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
14 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
15 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
16 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
17 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
18 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
19 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
20 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
21 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
22 State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of
23 funds appropriated under subsection 2(a) of this act
24 shall be the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of funds
25 appropriated under subsections 2(c) and 2(d) of this act

1 shall be the President of the Federated States of
2 Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of funds
3 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be
4 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
5 his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
6 appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act shall be
7 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the
8 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(2) of
9 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or
10 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
11 subsections 4(2) of this act shall be the Secretary of
12 the Department of Transportation, Communications and
13 Infrastructure, except that the allottee funds
14 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(f) shall be the
15 Pohnpei Port Authority (PPA); the allottee of funds
16 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(1) and
17 4(3)(m) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
18 Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
19 subsections 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the
20 Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti; the allottee of funds
21 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(e), 4(3)(f)
22 and 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the Meninkeder of
23 Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds appropriated under
24 subsections 4(3)(i) and 4(3)(j) of this act shall be the
25 Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs

1 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
2 subsection 4(3)(h) of this act shall be the Director of
3 COM-FSM Land Grant Program or his designee; the allottee
4 of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(n) of this
5 act shall be the Vice President of the Federated States
6 of Micronesia or his designee. The allottee of the funds
7 appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act
8 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the
9 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)
10 of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development
11 Authority (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated
12 under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of
13 Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee
14 of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this
15 act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;
16 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
17 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
18 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
19 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
20 30, 2022."

PUBLIC LAW No. 21-143

1 Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
