AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-115, 21-137, 21-165 and 21-178, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36 and 21-53, 21-56, 21-90,
3 21-115, 21-137 and 21-165, is hereby further amended to read as
4 follows:

5 "Section 4. Of the \$9,800,000 appropriated under this
6 act, \$2,800,000 shall be apportioned for public
7 projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei
8 State.

5 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-178, as amended by
6 Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-137 and
7 21-165, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

8 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
9 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
10 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
11 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
12 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
13 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
14 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
15 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
16 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
17 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
18 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
19 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
20 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the
21 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT
22 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
23 3(ad) of this act and 4(2)(q) shall be the President of
24 COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds
25 appropriated under subsections 3(ae) to 3(an) of this

1 act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
2 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
3 appropriated under subsection 3(a) of this act shall be
4 the Secretary of the FSM Department of Education or his
5 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
6 section 4 of this act shall be the President of the
7 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED
8 THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under section
9 4(1) and subsection 4(3)(w) of this act shall be the
10 Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia or
11 his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
12 subsection 4(3)(v) of this act shall be the Mayor of
13 Kolonia Town Government or his designee; the allottee of
14 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b)
15 and 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
16 Department of Health and Social Affairs or her designee;
17 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
18 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y) and 4(3)(z) of this act shall be the
19 Secretary of the Department of Education or his
20 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
21 subsections 4(3)(ab), 4(4)(f) and 4(3)(p) of this act
22 shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority, the funds
23 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(g) of this act shall
24 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
25 or his designee, the allottee of funds appropriated

1 under subsection 4(3)(x) of this act shall be the
 2 Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw Municipal Government
 3 or his designee; the funds appropriated under
 4 subsections 4(3)(i), 4(3)(j) of this act shall be the
 5 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
 6 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the
 7 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(ae)
 8 of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
 9 Resources and Development or his designee. The allottee
 10 of the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and
 11 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or
 12 his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated
 13 under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks
 14 Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of
 15 funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act
 16 shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
 17 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
 18 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern
 19 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the
 20 funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act
 21 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The
 22 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
 23 by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2022."

1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
