

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 18-98, 18-112, 18-122, 19-07, 19-24, 19-41, 19-52, 19-73, 19-82, 19-101, 19-114, 19-139, 20-07, 20-16, 20-36, 20-52, 20-84, 21-15, 21-113, 21-123 and 21-175, by amending section 4 thereof, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 18-70, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 18-98, 18-112, 18-122, 19-07, 19-24, 19-52 and
3 20-36, 20-52, 20-84 and 21-175, is hereby further amended to read
4 as follows:

5 "Section 4. Of the sum of \$5,100,000 appropriated by
6 this act, \$1,450,000 is apportioned for public projects
7 and social programs in the state of Pohnpei.
