

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-115, 21-137, 21-165, 21-178 and 21-200, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36 and 21-53, 21-56, 21-90,
3 21-115, 21-137, 21-165 and 21-200, is hereby further amended to
4 read as follows:

5 "Section 4. Of the \$9,800,000 appropriated under this
6 act, \$2,800,000 shall be apportioned for public
7 projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei
8 State.

9 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-178, as amended by
 10 Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-137 and
 11 21-165, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
 13 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
 14 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
 15 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
 16 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
 17 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
 18 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
 19 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
 20 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
 21 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
 22 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
 23 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
 24 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the
 25 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT

1 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
2 3(ad) of this act and 4(2)(q) shall be the President of
3 COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds
4 appropriated under subsections 3(ae) to 3(an) of this
5 act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
6 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
7 appropriated under subsection 3(al) of this act shall be
8 the Secretary of the FSM Department of Education or his
9 designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
10 section 4 of this act shall be the President of the
11 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED
12 THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
13 4(2)(c) of this act shall be the FSM Telecommunication
14 Corporation; the allottee of funds appropriated under
15 section 4(1) and subsection 4(3)(w) of this act shall be
16 the Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia
17 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
18 under subsection 4(3)(v) of this act shall be the Mayor
19 of Kolonia Town Government or his designee; the allottee
20 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b)
21 and 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
22 Department of Health and Social Affairs or her designee;
23 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
24 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y) and 4(3)(z) of this act shall be the
25 Secretary of the Department of Education or his

1 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
2 subsections 4(3)(ab), 4(4)(f) and 4(3)(p) of this act
3 shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority, the funds
4 appropriated under subsection 4(3)(g) of this act shall
5 be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
6 or his designee, the allottee of funds appropriated
7 under subsection 4(3)(x) of this act shall be the
8 Meninkeder Lapalap of Madolenihmw Municipal Government
9 or his designee; the funds appropriated under
10 subsections 4(3)(i), 4(3)(j) of this act shall be the
11 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
12 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the
13 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(ae)
14 of this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
15 Resources and Development or his designee. The allottee
16 of the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and
17 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or
18 his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated
19 under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks
20 Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of
21 funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act
22 shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
23 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
24 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern
25 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the

1 funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act
2 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The
3 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated
4 by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2022.”

5 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
6 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
7 becoming law without such approval.
