A RESOLUTION

Approving an application for a federal grant in the amount of \$190,915 and its submission to the United States, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), for the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS): Impact in Population Health.

1 WHEREAS, the United States, Centers for Disease Control and
2 Prevention, announced a funding opportunity for the Behavioral
3 Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS): Impact in Population
4 Health, which the FSM National Government could avail to support
5 its program; and

6 WHEREAS, the FSM Department of Health and Social Affairs
7 developed an application for funding to fund various activities in
8 connection with the program referred to as the FSM Behavioral Risk
9 Factor Surveillance System (BFRSS): Impact in Population Health;

10 WHEREAS, in accordance with section 210(2)(c) of title 55 of
11 the FSM Code (Annotated), as amended, any first time application
12 for foreign financial assistance shall require the approval by
13 Congress through resolution; now, therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-First Congress of the Federated
15 States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 2020, that the
16 submission of the grant application in the amount of \$190,915 to
17 the United States, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, is
18 hereby approved; and

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1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
2 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
3 of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of Health and
4 Social Affairs and the Secretary of Department of Justice.

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
