A RESOLUTION

Expressing the sincere condolences and sadness of the Twenty-First Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to the family of the late Honorable Chief Ramon Peyal, at his passing on December 29, 2020.

1 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Chief Ramon Peyal was born on
2 March 29, 1949, in Yap State, in Mogmog, Ulthi; and

3 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Chief Ramon Payal attended
4 university in 1970 at the University of Guam and in 1971 at the
5 University of Hawaii; and

6 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Chief Ramon Peyal began his
7 long career in government service in Yap State as an
8 Immigration Officer in 1970, the next year in 1971 he worked in
9 the Yap State Public Affairs Office for the year, then from
10 1974 to 1978 he was a classroom teacher in the Outer Islands of
11 Yap before returning to the Yap State Public Affairs Office
12 from 1978 to 1983, in all of these positions the late Honorable
13 Chief Ramon Peyal served admirably and was well respected in
14 his community, and

15 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Chief Ramon Peyal served as
16 the Administrative Officer of the Yap Congress Delegation
17 Office for twenty years between 1983 and 2003 where he
18 distinguished himself for his diligence and organization skills
19 throughout his long service; and

1 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Chief Ramon Peyal was elected
2 to the 13th Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia in
3 2003 as the At-Large Member from Yap State where he served as
4 the Vice Chairman of the Committee on Transportation &
5 Communications, and in 2005 in the 14th Congress of the
6 Federated States of Micronesia he served as the Vice Chairman
7 of the Committee on Resources & Development, and was valued for
8 his insight and competence in during his tenure at Congress;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Chief Ramon Peyal served in
11 the Council of Tamol and was the Chairman of the the Council of
12 Tamol from September 2015 until his passing, and is remembered
13 for his distinguished leadership in community and traditional
14 matters; and

15 WHEREAS, for 50 years the late Honorable Chief Ramon Peyal
16 served in Yap State and the National Government of the
17 Federated States of Micronesia and the Nation and the citizens
18 of Yap State have benefited greatly from his leadership and
19 knowledge over these many years; and

20 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of
21 Micronesia greatly appreciates the hard work of the late
22 Honorable Chief Ramon Peyal and his contributions to this
23 Nation and the citizens of Yap State, and it would like to
24 extend its sincere condolences to his family; and, therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED, the Twenty First Congress of the Federated

1 States of Micronesia, Sixth Regular Session, 2021, that
2 Congress hereby expresses its sincere condolences and sadness
3 to the family of the late Honorable Chief Ramon Peyal, at his
4 passing on December 29, 2020; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies be sent to
6 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, the
7 Chairman of the Council of Pilung, the Acting Chairman of the
8 Council of Tamol, the Governor of the Yap State, the Speaker of
9 the 10th Yap State Legislature and the family of the late
10 Honorable Chief Ramon Peyal.




