

A RESOLUTION

Expressing the sincere condolences and sadness of the Twenty-First Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to the family of the late Honorable Camillo Noket, Chief Justice of the Chuuk State Supreme Court, at his passing on May 4, 2020.

1 WHEREAS, the Honorable Camilla Noket, age 76, was born on
2 July 16, 1943, in Weno, Chuuk, and passed away on May 4, 2020;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, Camillo Noket attended Xavier High School from
5 1960-1963; and

6 WHEREAS, Camillo Noket attended the University of Guam from
7 1963-1964; and

8 WHEREAS, in 1980, Camillo Noket was the first Micronesian
9 to pass the FSM bar without formal attendance at a law school;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, Camillo Noket was a member of the Truk State
12 Legislature from 1968-1970 and a co-author of the Truk State
13 Charter; and

14 WHEREAS, in 1970, Camillo Noket was the Chairman of the
15 Truk Fishing Authority, the Chairman of the Truk State Foreign
16 Investment Board and a member of the Trust Territory Personnel
17 Board; and

1 WHEREAS, from 1982-1990, Camillo Noket worked for the
2 Micronesia Legal Services Corporation, including serving as the
3 Directing Attorney from 1986-1990; and

4 WHEREAS, in 1988 Camillo Noket was a member of the First
5 Chuuk State Constitutional Convention in 1988 where he served as
6 Chair of the Civil Liberties and Traditions Committee; and

7 WHEREAS, Camillo Noket served as the Chair of the Civil
8 Liberties and Traditions Committee for the Second FSM
9 Constitutional Convention in 1990; and

10 WHEREAS, in 2020, Camillo Noket was a delegate of the
11 Fourth FSM Constitutional Convention; and

12 WHEREAS, in 1990, Camillo Noket's career in the FSM
13 National Government began with his employment as an Assistant
14 Attorney General with the Department of Justice's Division of
15 International Law and he was appointed as the FSM Attorney
16 General from 1992-1998; and

17 WHEREAS, Camillo Noket was an Associate Justice of the
18 Chuuk State Supreme Court from 1998-1999; and

19 WHEREAS, from 1999-2006, Camillo Noket was again the
20 Directing Attorney of the Micronesia Legal Services Corporation
21 in Chuuk; and

22 WHEREAS, in 2019, Camillo Noket was the President of the
23 Pacific Judicial Council; and

24 WHEREAS, Camillo Noket served as the Chief Justice for the
25 Chuuk State Supreme Court from 2006 until his passing; and

1 WHEREAS, Camillo Noket is survived by his wife, Anna Noket
2 and his 5 children; and.

3 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-First Congress of the Federated
4 States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 2020, that Congress
5 hereby expresses its sincere condolences and sadness to the family
6 of the late Camillo Noket at his passing on May 4, 2020; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
8 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
9 of Micronesia and Anna Noket.
