

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant from the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in the amount of \$1,666,666, to provide funding for the project entitled: "Conduct Aeronautical Survey for RNAV Approach at Kosrae, Pohnpei and Yap International Airports", including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1 WHEREAS, on September 4, 2020, the U.S. FAA approved a
2 federal funding application for the project entitled: "Conduct
3 Aeronautical Survey for RNAV Approach at Kosrae, Pohnpei and Yap
4 International Airports", for the International Airports of Kosrae,
5 Pohnpei and Yap, in the amount of \$1,666,666; and

6 WHEREAS, the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia
7 wishes to express its sincere appreciation to the Government of
8 the United States and the United States of America and the U.S.
9 FAA for this generous grant; and

10 WHEREAS, this is a foreign financial assistance as defined
11 under section 210(1)(b) of title 55 of the Code of the Federated
12 States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended;

13 WHEREAS, section 210(2) title 55 of the Code of the Federated
14 States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, requires that for
15 foreign financial assistance to be valid it must be approved by
16 Congress by resolution; now, therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-First Congress of the Federated
18 States of Micronesia, Fifth Regular Session, 2020, that Congress
19 hereby approves and accepts the \$1,666,666 grant from the U.S. FAA
20 to fund the project entitled: "Conduct Aeronautical Survey for

1 RNAV Approach at Kosrae, Pohnpei and Yap International Airports",
2 for the International Airports of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Yap,
3 including all the terms and conditions thereof; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
5 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
6 of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
7 Communications and Infrastructure, the Secretary of the Department
8 of Finance and Administration, the Secretary of the Department of
9 Justice, and the U.S. Embassy in Kolonia.
