

A RESOLUTION

Expressing the sincere condolences and sadness of the Twenty-First Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to the family of the late Dr. Olter Paul at his passing on October 1, 2020.

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Olter Paul, age 88, was born on April 29,
2 1932, and passed away on October 1, 2020; and

3 WHEREAS, the late Dr. Olter Paul was one of Pohnpei
4 States' two remaining members of the Congress of Micronesia.

5 WHEREAS, the late Dr. Olter Paul was elected in 1965 as
6 the first Representative of District 14, namely Madolenihmw and
7 Kitti, to the House of Representatives in the First Congress of
8 Micronesia; and

9 WHEREAS, the late Dr. Olter Paul was re-elected to
10 maintain his seat in the next four Congressional Bodies, the
11 First to the Fourth Congress of Micronesia from 1965-1971; and

12 WHEREAS, during the First and Second Congress from
13 1965-1968, the late Dr. Olter Paul was Chairman of the House
14 Committee on Health, Education and Social Matters and in the
15 Third and Fourth Congress from 1969-1971, Dr. Paul held
16 Chairmanship of the House Committee on Judiciary and
17 Governmental Relations; and

18 WHEREAS, Dr. Olter Paul studied Dentistry in Fiji, Guam
19 and Michigan, and returned to the FSM upon completion of his
20 studies and served the then District of Ponape as the Director

1 of Dental Services from 1961-1968; and

2 WHEREAS, Dr. Olter Paul is survived by his children:
3 Molina, Oliver, Yosimi, Margaret, Miuky, Vanity, Ayumi and
4 Kenny, 22 grandchildren, 38 great grandchildren and 2 great
5 great-grandchildren; now, therefore,

6 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-First Congress of the
7 Federated States of Micronesia, Eighth Special Session, 2020,
8 that Congress hereby expresses its sincere condolences and
9 sadness to the family of the late Dr. Olter Paul at his passing
10 on October 1, 2020; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
12 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated
13 States of Micronesia and Molina Paul.
