RESOLUTION

Expressing the sincere sadness and condolences of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to the family of the late Jimmy G. Sablan, at his passing on April 4, 2019.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           WHEREAS, Jimmy G. Sablan, age 50, was born on January 26,  
2 1969, in Houk, Chuuk, and passed away on April 4, 2019, in  
3 Saipan; and

4           WHEREAS, Jimmy G. Sablan was a member of CNMI Catholic  
5 Association; was President of Namoi Taipung Association; was  
6 Treasurer of ACH Chuuk Association; was a member of Friends of  
7 Xavier - Saipan (FOX-Saipan); was a member of Statewide  
8 Independent Living Council (SILC); was a member of CNMI Council  
9 on Developmental Disabilities (CDD); and was a member of the  
10 Center for Living Independently (CLI) Board; and

11           WHEREAS, Jimmy G. Sablan attended the Northern Marianas  
12 College, where he graduate Cum Laude with an Associate of Arts  
13 in Liberal Arts and an Associate of Applied Science in Criminal  
14 Justice; and

15           WHEREAS, Jimmy G. Sablan received certificates of  
16 recognition for Outstanding Services as a Student Volunteer,  
17 Outstanding Services as a Tutor and Outstanding Leadership &  
18 Dedicated Service while attending Northern Marianas College;  
19 and

1           WHEREAS, Jimmy G. Sablan attended Xavier High School where  
2 he graduated with honors and served as Student Body President;  
3 and

4           WHEREAS, Jimmy G. Sablan was a staff member and tutor at  
5 Northern Marianas College, where he worked with high risk and  
6 gifted students to help them maximize their educational  
7 potential; and

8           WHEREAS, Jimmy G. Sablan was a client advocate for  
9 citizens of the FSM in Saipan, conducting outreach to clients  
10 with disabilities to ensure their issues were favorably  
11 resolved; and

12           WHEREAS, Jimmy G. Sablan was Program Manager for the  
13 Northern Marianas Protection & Advocacy Systems, Inc. where he  
14 was responsible for the administration of federally funded  
15 grant programs, including working with in house counsel,  
16 program advocates and other staff, while serving on multiple  
17 state and local boards; and

18           WHEREAS, Jimmy G. Sablan was one of 13 children of  
19 Greforia & Mary Sablan; and

20           WHEREAS, Jimmy G. Sablan is survived by his daughter,  
21 Temikah Jae Sablan; now, therefore,

22           BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-First Congress of the  
23 Federated States of Micronesia, Second Special Session, 2019,  
24 that the Congress hereby expresses its sincere sadness and

1 condolences to the family of the late Jimmy G. Sablan, at his  
2 passing on April 4, 2019; and
