## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-86, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allotte of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

All funds appropriated by this act shall be 8 9 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in 10 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee 11 12 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so 13 much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the 14 purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee 15 16 of the funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall 17 be the Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act 18 shall be the Governor of the State of Kosrae or his 19 20 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under 21 subsection 3(2) of this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town 22 Government or his designee. The allottee of funds 23 appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his 24 25 designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated
