

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-180, by amending sections 2 and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Yap and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
