## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$700,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, for the purpose of funding the FSMTCC — Open Access Entity (OAE), the 2023 Special Election, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. The sum of \$700,000, or so much thereof as may be
- 2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
- 3 Federated States of Micronesia for fiscal year ending September
- 4 30, 2023, for the purpose of funding the FSMTCC Open Access
- 5 Entity (OAE), and the July 2023 Special Election. The funds
- 6 appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as follows:
- 7 (1) FSMTCC Open Access Entity (OAE) ..... \$ 400,000
- 9 Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.
- 10 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
- 11 administered and
- 12 Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse date.
- 13 All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed,
- 14 administered and accounted for in accordance with applicable laws,
- 15 including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
- 16 1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
- 17 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
- 18 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are

1 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the 2 funds appropriated under Section 1(1) of this act shall be the 3 Secretary of the Department of Transportation, Communications and 4 Infrastructure or his designee. The allottee of the funds 5 appropriated under Section 1(2) of this act shall be the President 6 of the Federated States of Micronesia. The authority of the 7 allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on 8 September 30, 2023. Section 3.
