AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$8,820,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

The sum of \$8,820,000, or so much thereof as may 2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, for the purpose of funding public projects and 4 social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk 5 states.
