AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$5,600,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2023, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

23	administered and accounted for in accordance with applicab	le laws,
24	including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Ac	t of
25	1979. The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that	these

- 1 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for
- 2 the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are
- 3 incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the
- 4 funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
- 5 Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds
- 6 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the
- 7 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
- 8 EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under section 3(1)
- 9 of this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee;

The allottee of the funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall 10 be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be 11 the Faichuk Development Authority.
