PUBLIC LAW NO. 22-188

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-180, as amended by Public Law No. 22-187, by amending sections 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, for the purpose of changing the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

10	Section 5. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-180 is hereby
11	amended to read as follows:
12	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
13	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
14	managed, administered and accounted for in accordance with
15	applicable laws, including, but not limited to, the
16	Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be
17	responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much
18	thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose
19	specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred
20	in excess of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the
21	funds appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the
22	Governor of Yap State or his designee. The allottee of funds
23	appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the
24	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
25	designee; EXCEPT THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated

1	under section 3(1) of this act shall be the Governor of
2	Kosrae State or his designee; the allottee of funds
3	appropriated under section 3(2) of this act shall be the
4	Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee
5	of funds appropriated under subsections $4(1)(b)$, $4(1)(k)$,
6	4(1)(1), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e),
7	4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(n), 4(2)(p), 4(2)(s), 4(2)(t),
8	4(2)(u) and $4(2)(v)$ of this act shall be the Secretary of
9	the Department of Transportation, Communications and
10	Infrastructure or his designee; the allottee of funds
11	appropriated under subsections $4(1)(a)$, $4(1)(j)$, $4(2)(f)$,
12	4(2)(j), $4(2)(k)$, $4(2)(1)$, $4(2)(m)$, $4(2)(r)$, $4(2)(x)$,
13	4(3)(m) and 4(2)(n) of this act shall be the Pohnpei
14	Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds
15	appropriated under subsection 4(2)(i) of this act shall be
16	the Secretary of the Department of Education or her
17	designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
18	subsection 4(2)(o) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Port
19	Authority (PPA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
20	subsections $4(2)(w)$, $4(2)(q)$, $4(2)(y)$ and $4(2)(z)$ of this
21	act shall be the Mayor of Sapwuahfik Municipal Government or
22	his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
23	subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor
24	of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of the funds
25	appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the

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1	Mortlocks Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allotted
2	of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act
3	shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his
4	designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
5	subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas
6	Development Authority; the allottee of the funds
7	appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be the
8	Faichuk Development Authority. The authority of the
9	allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall
10	lapse on September 30, 2025.
11	Section 6. This act shall become law upon approval by the
12	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
13	becoming law without such approval.
