Dear Speaker Simina:

I am pleased to transmit herewith the enclosed Congressional Act, which I have signed to become Public Law No. 22–59 , with line-item vetoes as stated below:

Congressional Act No. 22-47, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-60, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 20-65, 20-75, 20-85, 20-97, 20-150, 21-69, 21-84, 21-100, 21-129, 21-163, 21-173, 21-187 AND 22-11, BY AMENDING SECTION 5 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS IN THE STATE OF CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Our records from Finance show that the concerned funds have been allotted and there is insufficient funding to accommodate the proposed changes for line-item sections 5(6)(b), 5(6)(d), 5(6)(g), and 5(6)(g). Therefore, I respectfully veto those line-items.

To further amend Public Law No. 20-60, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-75, 20-85, 20-97, 20-150, 21-69, 21-84, 21-100, 21-129, 21-163, 21-173, 21-187 and 22-11, by amending section 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
