CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 22-175, C.D.1

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-86, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-101 and 22-102, by amending sections 3, 4 and 5 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other public projects and social programs for the people of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:


