I am transmitting the following act, which I have signed to become Public Law No. 22–137 with item veto for the reason stated in this transmittal:

Congressional Act No. 22-127, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND SECTIONS 9 AND 12 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-185, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 21-210, 21-221, 21-238, 22-01, 22-30, AND 22-41, TO CHANGE THE USE OF CERTAIN FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, TO CHANGE THE ALLOTTEE OF CERTAIN FUNDS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Regarding the \$120,000 appropriation under section 9(11)(q), I have been advised that the funding for this line is insufficient to accommodate the amendment. Hence, I regret that I must veto this line item. Thank you.



#### AN ACT

To further amend sections 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 21-185, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-210, 21-221, 21-238, 22-01, 22-30, and 22-41, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to change the allottee of certain funds, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 21-185, as amended by

2 Public Laws Nos. 21-210, 21-221 21-238, 22-01, 22-30, and 22-41 is

3 hereby further amended to read as follows:

4	"Section 9. Capital and Human Resources Development.
5	The sum of \$16,473,088 or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
7	of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal
8	year ending September 30, 2021, for the following
9	capital improvements, development programs, and projects
10	and human resources development. Of the total amount of
11	funds appropriated herein, \$1,246,022 shall be deemed to
12	come from funds available under the Supplemental
13	Education Grant and \$1,000,000 shall be deemed to come
14	from funds available under the Compact Sector Grants.

16	apportioned as follows:

15	by Public Laws Nos. 21-210, 21-221, 21-238, 22-01, and 22-41 is
16	hereby further amended to read as follows:
17	"Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and
18	Lapse Dates.
19	(1) <u>General provisions</u> .
20	(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
21	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
22	accordance with applicable law, including, but not
23	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
24	(b) The allottees shall be responsible for
25	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be

1	necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
2	this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
3	of the sums appropriated.
4	(2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
5	appropriated by this act are as follows:
6	(a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds
7	shall be the President of the Federated States of
8	Micronesia;
9	(b) Section 3 - the allottee of these funds
10	shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
11	States of Micronesia;
12	(c) Section $4$ — the allottee of these funds
13	shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
14	Federated States of Micronesia;
15	(d) Section 5 — the allottee of these funds
16	shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of

19	funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
20	Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that for the following
21	subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:
22	(i) Sections $8(1)(f)$ and $8(13)(q)$ - the
23	allottee of these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint
24	Committee on Compact Review and Planning;
25	(ii) Section 8(8)(a) — the allottee of these

1	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Kosrae;
2	(iii) Section $8(8)(b)$ — the allottee of these
3	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Pohnpei;
4	(iv) Section $8(8)(c)$ - the allottee of these
5	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Chuuk;
6	(v) Section $8(8)(d)$ - the allottee of these
7	funds shall be the Governor of the state of Yap;
8	(vi) Section 8(11) - the allottee of these

22	Court of the Federated States of Micronesia;
23	(xi) Section 8(13)(t) - the allottee of
24	these funds shall be the National Olympic Committee;
25	(xii) Section 8(13)(u) - the allottee of

1	these funds shall be the Principal of Saint Cecilia
2	Catholic School;
3	(xiiii) Section $9(1)$ — the allottee of these
4	funds shall be the President of the College of
5	Micronesia-FSM;
