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

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 22-86, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 22-101, 22-102 and 22-106, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding priority infrastructure projects and other public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-86, as amended by  
2 Public Law No. 22-102, is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
4 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
5 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
6 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
7 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
8 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
9 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
10 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
11 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
12 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
13 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
14 State or his designee. The allottee of funds  
15 appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act shall be  
16 the Governor of the State of Kosrae or his designee; the  
17 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(2) of  
18 this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or  
19 his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
20 section 4 of this act shall be the President of the  
21 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED  
22 THAT, the allottee of funds appropriated under  
23 subsection 4(1)(c) of this act shall be the FSM  
24 Telecommunication Corporation; the allottee of funds  
25 appropriated under subsection 4(1)(g) of this act shall

1           be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC); the allottee  
2           of funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a),  
3           4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(h),  
4           4(2)(i), 4(2)(j), 4(2)(l), 4(3)(b), 4(3)(c), 4(3)(d),  
5           4(3)(e) 4(3)(f), 4(3)(q) and 4(3)(r) of this act shall  
6           be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the  
7           allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
8           4(1)(j), 4(2)(d) and 4(3)(l) of this act shall be the  
9           Secretary of the Department of Resources and Development  
10          or her designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated  
11          under subsections 4(1)(b), 4(1)(d), 4(1)(e), 4(1)(f),  
12          4(1)(h), 4(1)(k), 4(1)(l), 4(1)(m), 4(1)(n), 4(2)(g),  
13          4(3)(a), 4(3)(g), 4(3)(h), 4(3)(j) and 4(3)(k) of this  
14          act shall be the Secretary of the Department of  
15          Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his  
16          designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
17          subsection 4(2)(k) of this act shall be the President of  
18          the COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds  
19          appropriated under subsections 4(1)(i) 4(3)(o) and  
20          4(3)(i) of this act shall be the Secretary of the  
21          Department of Health and Social Affairs or her designee;  
22          the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
23          4(3)(m) of this act shall be the Vice President of the  
24          Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the  
25          allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(n)



1 of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of  
2 Madolenihmw. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
3 under subsections 5(1), 5(2) and 5(7) of this act shall  
4 be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the  
5 allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(3)  
6 of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island Development  
7 Authority (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated  
8 under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Mayor of  
9 Weno Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee  
10 of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this  
11 act shall be the Southern Namoneas Development  
12 Authority; the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
13 subsection 5(6) of this act shall be the Faichuk  
14 Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to  
15 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on  
16 September 30, 2024."

1       Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
