Congressional Act No. 22-149, entitled: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 9 AND 12 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 19-118, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, 20-01, 20-14, 20-23, 20-74 AND 20-129, IN ORDER TO CHANGE THE USE AND ALLOTTEE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING CAPITAL AND HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT FOR THE STATE OF CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

This Congressional Act is amending both Public Laws Nos. 20-74 and 20-129 by changing the use and allottee of funds to fund Capital and Human Resources for the State of Chuuk.

AN ACT

To amend sections 9 and 12 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, 20-01, 20-14, 20-23, 20-74 and 20-129, in order to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein for the purpose of funding capital and human resources development for the state of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 9 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by 1
- 2 Public Laws Nos. 19-125, 19-131, 19-135, 19-146, 19-160, 20-01,
- 3 20-14, 20-23 and 20-74, is hereby further amended to read as
- 4 follows:

5	"Section 9. <u>Capital and Human Resources Development</u> .
6	The sum of \$40,606,363, which includes \$556,074 in SEG
7	funding that was previously omitted, or so much thereof
8	as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
9	General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
10	the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, for the
11	following capital improvements, development programs,
12	and projects and human resources development. Of the
13	total amount of funds appropriated herein, \$1,802,096
14	shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
15	Amended Compact from the Supplemental Education Grant
16	and \$9,545,500 shall be deemed to come from funds
17	available under the Amended Compact from Compact Sector

1	Grants. The sum appropriated by this section shall be
2	apportioned as follows:

1	Section 2. Section 12 of Public Law No. 19-118, as amended by
2	Public Law Nos. 19-125, 19-135, 20-01, 20-46 and 20-129, is hereby
3	further amended to read as follows:
4	"Section 12. Allotment and Management of Funds and Lapse
5	Dates.
6	(1) General provisions.
7	(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
8	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
9	accordance with applicable law, including, but not
10	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.
11	(b) The allottees shall be responsible for
12	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
13	necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in
14	this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
15	of the sums appropriated.
16	(2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
17	appropriated by this act are as follows:
18	(a) Section 2 - the allottee of these funds
19	shall be the President of the Federated States of
20	Micronesia;
21	(b) Section 3 — the allottee of these funds
22	shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
23	States of Micronesia;
24	(c) Section 4 — the allottee of these funds
25	shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the

1	Federated States of Micronesia;
2	(d) Section 5 - the allottee of these funds
3	shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
4	Micronesia;
5	(e) Sections 6 through 9 - the allottee of these
6	funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
7	Micronesia; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the following
8	subsections of sections 8 through 9 of this act:
9	(i) Section $8(1)(g)(ii)$ — the allottee of
10	these funds shall be the Chair of the Joint Committee on
11	Compact Review and Planning (JCRP);
12	(ii) Section $8(6)(g)$ — the allottee of these
13	funds shall be the President of the College of
14	Micronesia - FSM;
15	(iii) Section 8(6)(h) through (i) and Section
16	8(8)(c) — the allottee of these funds shall be the
17	Governor of Chuuk State;
18	(iv) Section $8(9)(a)$ through (x) — the
19	allottee of these funds shall be the Speaker of the
20	Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia;
21	(v) Section $8(12)(a)$ through (d) - the
22	allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of
23	the respective State Supreme Court;
24	(vi) Section $8(12)(0)$ - the allottee of
25	these funds shall be the Governor of the respective

1	States;
2	(vii) Section $8(12)(p)$ - the allottee of
3	these funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap;
4	(viii) Section $9(1)(a)$ through (c) - the
5	allottee of these funds shall be the President of the
6	College of Micronesia-FSM;
7	(ix) Section $9(3)(i)(i)$ - the allottee of
8	these funds shall be the Governor of the State of Yap;
9	(x) Section $9(3)(i)(iv)$, Section $9(12)(g)$
10	and Section 9(12)(h) - the allottee of these funds shall
11	be the Governor of the State of Chuuk;
12	(xi) Section $9(4)(b)$ through (e) - the
13	allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of the
14	respective States;
15	(xii) Section $9(12)(b)$ — the allottee of
16	these funds shall be the Chief Justice of the Chuuk
17	State Supreme Court;
18	(xiii) Section $9(12)(d)$ — the allottee of
19	these funds shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the
20	Federated States of Micronesia.
21	(xiv) Sections $9(12)(i)$, (j) , and (k) - the
22	allottee of these funds shall be the Governor of the
23	State of Chuuk.
24	(3) Lapse date. The authority of the allottee to
25	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as

1	of September 30, 2017, PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the funds
2	appropriated under section $8(1)(g)$ and section 9 of this
3	act shall not lapse and the funds appropriated under
4	Section 8(12)(p) shall not lapse until September 30,
5	2018."
6	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
7	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
8	becoming law without such approval.
