

FIRST REGULAR SESSION, 2021 CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 22-20, C.D.1

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 19-64, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 19-81, 19-97, 19-120, 19-137, 20-29, 20-86, 20-119, 21-31 and 21-160, by amending sections 1 and 2 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the state of Pohnpei, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 19-64, as amended by
2	Public Laws Nos. 19-81, 19-97, 19-120, 19-137, 20-29 and 20-119, is
3	hereby further amended to read as follows:
4	"Section 1. Purpose. The sum of \$3,050,000, or so much
5	thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from
6	the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia
7	for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2016, for the
8	purpose of funding public projects and social programs
9	in the states of Kosrae and Pohnpei. The funds
10	appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as
11	follows:

3	Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 19-64, as amended by
4	Public Laws Nos. 19-81, 19-97, 20-86, 20-119, 21-31 and 21-160, is
5	hereby further amended to read as follows:
6	"Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
7	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
8	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
9	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
10	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
11	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
12	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
13	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
14	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
15	appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
16	under section 1 of this act shall be the President of
17	the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee;
18	PROVIDED THAT, the funds appropriated under subsections
19	1(d) shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
20	designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
21	subsections $1(2)(1)(a)-(o)$, $1(2)(2)(a)$, $1(2)(2)(c)$,
22	1(2)(2)(0), $1(2)(4)(a)-(j)$ shall be the Pohnpei
23	Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds
24	appropriated under subsections 1(2)(2)(b), 1(2)(2)(d),
25	1(2)(2)(e), $1(2)(2)(f)$ and $1(2)(2)(n)$ shall be the

	Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
2	Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the
3	allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
4

8	designee; the allottee of fund appropriated under
9	subsections $1(2)(4)(k)-(s)$ shall be the Governor of the
10	State of Pohnpei. The authority of the allottee to
11	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
12	September 30, 2022."
13	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
14	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
15	becoming law without such approval.
