CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 22-52

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 21-157, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-179, 21-216 and 22-17, by amending section 2 thereof, to change the use of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Yap State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 21-157, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 21-179, 21-216 and 22-17, is hereby further amended  
3 to read as follows:

4               "Section 2. Of the 2,100,000 appropriated under this act,  
5               \$300,000 shall be apportioned to fund public projects and  
6               social programs for the people of Yap State.

8               (a) Power Utility Costs for

9               Dispensaries using EF2 in the Outer

10              Islands of Yap ..... 100,000

11              (b) Amin, Maap Coastal Road Project

12              Supplemental Funding ..... 70,000

14              Project Supplemental funding ..... 45,000

15              (d) Financial Assistance for Yapese

16              Students at COM-FSM National Campus, PROVIDED


17              THAT an eligible recipient must be a fulltime

1           a GPA of 2.00 or better ..... \$     40,000  
 2                   (e) Nef, Kanifay Basketball

 4                   (f) Fadrai, Ulithi Water Catchment
