## A RESOLUTION

To amend Rule 3 of the Official Rules of Procedure for the Twenty-Second Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to clarify that Congressional Members participating remotely in any congressional session must participate remotely via videoconference and have their camera on throughout the congressional session in order to considered present for quorum count, voting and attendance purposes.

- 1 WHEREAS, the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 2 is governed by its Official Rules of Procedure; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Rule 3 of the Official Rules of Procedure of the
- 4 Twenty-Second Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 5 stipulates that a majority of Congressional Members shall be
- 6 present to constitute a quorum for the transaction of business
- 7 and Congressional Members absent without leave of Speaker shall
- 8 be noted as absent in the Journal; and
- 9 WHEREAS, a Congressional Resolution is a transparent and
- 10 open mechanism for an amendment to the Official Rules of
- 11 Procedure; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the Members of the Twenty-Second Congress of the
- 13 Federated States of Micronesia desire to amend Rule 3 of the
- 14 Official Rules of Procedure to require Congressional Members
- 15 participating in congressional sessions remotely to participate
- 16 via videoconference and have their camera on throughout the
- 17 congressional session in order to considered present for quorum
- 18 count, voting and attendance purposes; and

- 1 WHEREAS, COVID-19 continues to impact the ability of the
- 2 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to meet in
- 3 person for Congressional sessions; now, therefore,
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Second Congress of the
- 5 Federated States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session,
- 6 2022, that Rule 3 of the Official Rules of Procedure of the
- 7 Twenty-Second Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 8 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 9 "RULE 3. QUORUM AND ATTENDANCE.
- 10 A majority of the Members shall constitute a quorum for the
- 11 transaction of business. A majority of less than a quorum
- 12 shall have the power to compel the attendance of absent Members
- 13 and to adjourn from day to day. For the opening day of
- 14 session, at least one Member from each of the four States shall
- 15 be included in the initial quorum unless sufficient notice was
- 16 given to permit the attendance of the Members absent and they
- 17 do not answer to the quorum count. In addition to the member
- 18 requirement to answer to the quorum count, members
- 19 participating remotely shall participate via videoconference
- 20 and have their camera on throughout the session in order to be
- 21 considered present for any quorum count, voting and attendance
- 22 purposes. The Speaker may declare the Congress adjourned if no
- 23 quorum is present at the hour of opening. For purposes of
- 24 ascertaining whether a quorum exists, the Speaker shall count
- 25 the Members present. During a meeting of the Congress, any

Member may call upon the Speaker to determine whether a quorum 2 exists or not, and the Speaker shall so determine and announce 3 his finding. A Member shall not be absent unless he has leave of the Speaker, subject to appeal to the Congress. The name of 5 a Member not present to answer to a quorum count and call for a vote, without their camera on for members participating 6 7 remotely, and not excused by the Speaker, shall be noted on the 8 Journal as absent; and 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 10 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated 11 States of Micronesia. 12 13 Date: 4/20/22 Introduced by: /s/ Esmond B.
