- 1 WHEREAS, the Eastern Micronesia Cable (EMC) is a critical
- 2 infrastructure investment providing broadband connectivity for the
- 3 FSM to Nauru and Kiribati via Kosrae, with grant funding from
- 4 Australia, Japan and the United States; and
- 5 WHEREAS, the ongoing litigation between the Open Access
- 6 Entity and the FSM Telecommunications Corporation brings some
- 7 uncertainty to the ability of the FSM to be able to join the EMC
- 8 Project due to delays; and
- 9 WHEREAS, on October 25, 2022, the FSM Supreme Court Trial
- 10 Division issued a partial summary judgment disposing most of the
- 11 legal issues presented and declaring that the IRU Deed executed by
- 12 the parties is a valid and enforceable legal document; and
- 13 WHEREAS, it is crucial for the FSM to commit to the EMC
- 14 Project and terminate any further litigation that will obstruct
- 15 implementation of this project; now, therefore,
- 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Second Congress of the Federated
- 17 States of Micronesia, Sixth Special Session, 2022, that Congress
- 18 hereby wishes to express policy discretion and its intention for
- 19 the FSM to join the EMC Project that guarantees broadband
- 20 connectively for the FSM via Kosrae, and further urge all parties
