

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-115, 21-137, 21-165, 21-178, 21-200, 21-218, 21-226, 21-249 and 21-256, by amending sections 4 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended  
2 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-90,  
3 21-115, 21-137, 21-165, 21-200, 21-218, 21-226 and 21-249, is  
4 hereby further amended to read as follows:

5 "Section 4. Of the \$9,800,000 appropriated under this  
6 act, \$2,800,000 shall be apportioned for public  
7 projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei  
8 State.

12 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-178, as amended  
 13 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-137.  
 14 21-165, 21-218, 21-226 and 21-249, is hereby further amended to  
 15 read as follows:

16 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
 17 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
 18 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
 19 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
 20 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
 21 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
 22 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
 23 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
 24 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
 25 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated

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1 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
2 State or his designee. The allottee of funds  
3 appropriated under sections 3(a) to 3(ar) of this act  
4 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his  
5 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds  
6 appropriated under subsections 3(ad) and 4(2)(q) of this  
7 act shall be the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of  
8 funds appropriated under subsection 3(al) of this act  
9 shall be the Secretary of the FSM Department of  
10 Education or his designee. The allottee of funds  
11 appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the  
12 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his  
13 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds  
14 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c) of this act shall  
15 be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of  
16 funds appropriated under section 4(1), subsections  
17 4(3)(i), 4(3)(j) and [subsection] 4(3)(w) of this act  
18 shall be the [~~Vice President of the Federated States of~~  
19 ~~Micronesia]~~ Secretary of the Department of  
20 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his  
21 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
22 subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act  
23 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Health and  
24 Social Affairs or her designee; the allottee of funds  
25 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y) and



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1           4(3)(z) of this act shall be the Secretary of the  
2           Department of Education or his designee; the allottee of  
3           funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(ab), 4(4)(f)  
4           and 4(3)(p) of this act shall be the Pohnpei  
5           Transportation Authority, the funds appropriated under  
6           subsection 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the President of  
7           the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, the  
8           allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(x)  
9           of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of  
10          Madolenihmw Municipal Government or his designee; [~~the~~  
11          ~~funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(i), 4(3)(j) of~~  
12          ~~this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of~~  
13          ~~Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his~~  
14          ~~designee~~]; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
15          subsection 4(3)(ae) of this act shall be the Secretary  
16          of the Department of Resources and Development or his  
17          designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under  
18          subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the  
19          Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of  
20          the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act  
21          shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority  
22          (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under  
23          subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno  
24          Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of  
25          the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act

1 shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;  
2 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
3 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development  
4 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate  
5 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September  
6 30, 2022.”

7 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
8 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
9 becoming law without such approval.
