

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-115, 21-137, 21-165, 21-178, 21-200, 21-218, 21-226, 21-249, 22-27, 22-63, 22-73 and 22-82, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended
2 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-07, 21-53, 21-56, 21-90, 21-165, 22-
3 27 and 22-73, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 5. Of the \$9,800,000 appropriated under this
5 act, \$4,200,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
6 and social programs for the people of Chuuk State.

2 Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-178, as amended
3 by Public Laws Nos. 21-01, 21-36, 21-53, 21-56, 21-102, 21-137,
4 21-165, 21-218, 21-226, 21-249 and 22-63, is hereby further
5 amended to read as follows:

6 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
7 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
8 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
9 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
10 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
11 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
12 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
13 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
14 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
15 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
16 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
17 State or his designee. The allottee of funds
18 appropriated under sections 3(a) to 3(as) of this act
19 shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
20 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
21 appropriated under subsections 3(ad) and 4(2)(q) of this
22 act shall be the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of
23 funds appropriated under subsection 3(al) of this act
24 shall be the Secretary of the FSM Department of
25 Education or his designee. The allottee of funds

1 appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his
3 designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds
4 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c) of this act shall
5 be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority; the allottee of
6 funds appropriated under section 4(1) and subsection
7 4(3)(w) of this act shall be the Vice President of the
8 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee; the
9 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
10 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and 4(3)(c) of this act shall be the
11 Secretary of the Department of Health and Social Affairs
12 or her designee; the allottee of funds appropriated
13 under subsections 4(3)(d), 4(3)(y) and 4(3)(z) of this
14 act shall be the Secretary of the Department of
15 Education or his designee; the allottee of funds
16 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(ab), 4(4)(f) and
17 4(3)(p) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
18 Authority, the funds appropriated under subsection
19 4(3)(g) of this act shall be the President of the
20 Federated States of Micronesia or his designee, the
21 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(3)(x)
22 of this act shall be the Meninkeder Lapalap of
23 Madolenihmw Municipal Government or his designee; the
24 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(i), 4(3)(j) of
25 this act shall be the Secretary of the Department of

1 Transportation, Communications and Infrastructure or his
2 designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
3 subsection 4(3)(ae) of this act shall be the Secretary
4 of the Department of Resources and Development or his
5 designee. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
6 subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act shall be the
7 Governor of Chuuk State or his designee; the allottee of
8 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act
9 shall be the Mortlocks Island Development Authority
10 (MIDA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
11 subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno
12 Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
13 the funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act
14 shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;
15 the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection
16 5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development
17 Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate
18 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
19 30, 2024.”

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1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
