PUBLIC LAW NO. 22-52

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 22-48, by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein for the purpose of funding public projects and social programs in the states of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 22-48 is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:

3 "Section 3. Of the \$4,200,000 appropriated under this
4 act, \$600,000 shall be apportioned for public projects
5 and social programs for the people of Kosrae State.

12 Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 22-48 is hereby
13 amended to read as follow:

14 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
15 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
16 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
17 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
18 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
19 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
20 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
21 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
22 obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
23 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
24 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
25 State or his designee. The allottee of funds appropriated

1 under section 3(1) of this act shall be the Governor of
2 Kosrae State or his designee. The allottee of funds
3 appropriated under section 3(2) shall be the Mayor Lelu
4 Town Government or his designee. The allottee of funds
5 appropriated under section 4 of this act shall be the
6 Governor of Pohnpei State or his designee EXCEPT THAT, the
7 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(i) of
8 this act shall be the Mayor of Pingelap Municipal
9 Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under
10 subsections 4(1)(c), 4(2)(a), 4(2)(b), 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e),
11 4(2)(i), 4(2)(l), 4(4)(a), 4(4)(b), 4(4)(d), 4(4)(e) and
12 4(4)(h) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
13 Authority, (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated under
14 subsections 4(1)(a), 4(1)(b), 4(1)(d), 4(1)(e), 4(1)(f),
15 4(1)(g), 4(1)(h), 4(2)(c), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(j),
16 4(2)(k), 4(2)(m) and 4(2)(n), of this act shall be the
17 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
18 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the
19 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(h)
20 of this act shall be the Mayor of Kolonia Town Government
21 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
22 subsection 4(3)(a) of this act shall be the Luhk en
23 Moanlap of Kitti; the allottee of funds appropriated under
24 subsection 4(4)(i) of this act shall be the Mayor of
25 Mwokilloa Municipal Government or his designee; the

1 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 4(4)(j) of
2 this act shall be the Mayor of Pingelap Municipal
3 Government or his designee. The allottee of the funds
4 appropriated under sections 5(1) and 5(6) of this act
5 shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee. The
6 allottee of the funds appropriated under section 5(2) of
7 this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development
8 Authority. The allottee of the funds appropriated under
9 section 5(3) of this act shall be the Mayor of Weno
10 Municipal Government or his designee. The allottee of the
11 funds appropriated under section 5(4) of this act shall be
12 the Southern Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee
13 of the funds appropriated under section 5(5) of this act
14 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority, EXCEPT THAT
15 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
16 5(5)(a) of this act shall be the Chuuk Public Utility
17 Corporation (CPUC). The authority of the allottee to
18 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
19 September 30, 2023.”

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1 Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
