A RESOLUTION

Expressing the sincere condolences and sadness of the Twenty-Second Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to the family of the late Honorable Anthony Tareg at his passing on August 26, 2022.

1 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Anthony Tareg, was an
2 extraordinarily dedicated and diligent individual with a career
3 in government service spanning 50 years; and

4 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Anthony Tareg served in Yap
5 State government, benefiting the citizens of Yap State and our
6 Nation as a whole; and

7 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Anthony Tareg began his career
8 at the Yap State Department of Youth & Civic Affairs (1972-1983)
9 as a Radio Announcer and was promoted to Radio News Reporter;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Anthony Tareg then served as
12 Legislative Liaison Officer (1983-1988), in 1988 he became the
13 Yap State Chief of the Division of Public Affairs; and

14 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Anthony Tareg became the
15 Assistant Director of the Department of Youth & Civic Affairs in
16 1989 and was later nominated and confirmed as the Director of
17 the Department of Youth & Civic Affairs in 1993; and

18 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Anthony Tareg throughout his
19 service at the Department of Youth & Civic Affairs was known for
20 his strong promotion of community and youth matters; and

1 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Anthony Tareg was elected to
2 serve in the Yap State Legislature as a State Senator
3 representing Election District 2 in January 1999 and served in
4 this capacity with distinction until January 2007; and

5 WHEREAS, as a recognized senior leader the late Honorable
6 Anthony Tareg was elected as the Yap State Lieutenant Governor
7 in January 2007 and served in that capacity until January
8 2014; and

9 WHEREAS, as Lieutenant Governor the late Honorable
10 Anthony Tareg was known for his desire for appropriate and
11 sustainable development in balance with strong traditional
12 values; and

13 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Anthony Tareg lived his
14 commitment to his community and traditional values, and in
15 2015 he took up the Traditional Chief position as a member of
16 the Council of Tamol for his island of Fadrai, and he served
17 in this capacity until his passing; now, therefore,

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Second Congress of the
19 Federated States of Micronesia, Fourth Regular Session, 2022,
20 that Congress hereby expresses its sincere condolences and
21 sadness to the family of the late Honorable Anthony Tareg at his
22 passing on August 26, 2022; and


