

A RESOLUTION

Approving and accepting a grant from the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in the amount of \$37,222,222, to provide funding for the 'Yap International Airport Runway Rehabilitation Project', including all the terms and conditions of the assistance.

1 WHEREAS, on July 14, 2021, the U.S FAA approved a federal
2 funding application submitted by the Government of the Federated
3 States of Micronesia and awarded a grant in the amount of
4 \$37,222,222 to fund the 'Yap International Airport Runway
5 Rehabilitation Project'; and

6 WHEREAS, on July 15, 2021, the FAA, on behalf of the U.S.
7 Government, and the Department of Transportation, Communications &
8 Infrastructure and the Department of Justice, on behalf of the FSM
9 Government, have executed the FAA AIP Grant Agreement for the
10 project; and

11 WHEREAS, the budget period for the grant, as stated in the
12 executed AIP Grant Agreement, is 4 years, or 1,460 calendar days,
13 from the date of acceptance of the grant; and

14 WHEREAS, the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia
15 wishes to express its sincere appreciation to the Government of
16 the United States of America and the U.S. FAA for this generous
17 grant; and

1 WHEREAS, this is a foreign financial assistance as defined
2 under Section 210(1)(b) of title 55 of the Code of the Federated
3 States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended; and

4 WHEREAS, section 210(2) of title 55 of the Code of the
5 Federated States of Micronesia (Annotated), as amended, requires
6 that for foreign financial assistance to be valid it must be
7 approved by Congress by resolution; now, therefore,

8 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Second Congress of the Federated
9 States of Micronesia, First Special Session, 2021, that Congress
10 hereby approves and accepts the \$37,222,222 grant from the U.S.
11 FAA to fund the 'Yap International Airport Runway Rehabilitation
12 Project', including all the terms and conditions thereof; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOVED that certified copies of this
14 resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States
15 of Micronesia, the Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
16 Communications and Infrastructure, the Secretary of the Department
17 of Finance and Administration, the Secretary of the Department of
18 Justice and the U.S. Embassy in Kolonia.
