## A RESOLUTION

Expressing the sincere condolences and sadness of the Twenty-Third Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia to the family of the late Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly, Senator of the Twenty-Third Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia representing Congressional District One of the state of Kosrae, at his passing on January 5, 2024.

- 1 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly was born in
- 2 Kosrae on December 24, 1951, and showed exemplary discipline and
- 3 intelligence at a young age, graduating as class valedictorian in
- 4 both elementary (1967) and high school (1971); and
- 5 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly attended the
- 6 United States International University (USIU) in Maui, Hawaii and
- 7 San Diego, California, before enlisting in the United States
- 8 Marine Corps at Camp Pendleton in Field Artillery in June 1974, as
- 9 Fire Direction Control Man, until he was honorably discharged in
- 10 August 1978; and
- 11 WHEREAS, following his commendable service and honorable
- 12 discharge from the United States Marine Corps, the late Honorable
- 13 Paliknoa K. Welly worked in management for the Circle-K
- 14 Corporation in San Diego and, simultaneously, in 1991 enrolled at
- 15 California State University Turtlock, where he graduated in 1994
- 16 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice/Law
- 17 Enforcement; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly returned to his
- 19 cherished home state of Kosrae in 1995 and began his long and
- 20 notable career in public service, working for the State Government

- 1 as the Administrative Officer for the Department of Education
- 2 while again, simultaneously, pursuing further education by
- 3 enrolling in an extension program through the University of
- 4 Hawaii-Manoa for a Master's degree in Education Administration
- 5 and, upon completion of his Master's degree served as the
- 6 Community Development Officer for the College of Micronesia for
- 7 three years from 1999 to 2001; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly became a member
- 9 of the Kosrae state Bar in December 2001 and began serving as
- 10 Chief Prosecutor for the state of Kosrae; in 2005 the late
- 11 Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly became a member of the FSM Bar and in
- 12 2006 accepted the position of Environmental Lawyer for the Kosrae
- 13 Island Resource Management Authority (KIRMA); and
- 14 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly was first
- 15 elected to the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia in
- 16 2007, as the two-year Senator representing Congressional District
- 17 One of Kosrae to the Fifteenth Congress and, in recognition of his
- 18 dedication, accomplishments, and exceptional service, was re-
- 19 elected by his constituents in each subsequent election up to and
- 20 including election to the current Twenty-Third Congress; and
- 21 WHEREAS, the late Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly was selected as
- 22 Chair of the Congressional Standing Committee on External Affairs
- 23 for the Fifteenth through Seventeenth Congress, served as Vice
- 24 Speaker for the Eighteenth Congress, and again selected as Chair
- 25 of the Congressional Standing Committee on External Affairs for

- 1 the Nineteenth through Twenty-Third Congress, while also serving
- 2 on the Committees on Judiciary and Governmental Operations and
- 3 Ways and Means, and Chair of the Kosrae Delegation; and
- WHEREAS, the late Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly was held in
- 5 high regard by all those fortunate to have the opportunity to work
- 6 with him and is remembered as a man of highest integrity, with
- 7 dedication to service and tremendous leadership, and an unending
- 8 commitment to the development, growth, and protection of our
- 9 Nation; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the people of the Federated States of Micronesia
- 11 have benefited immeasurably from the life and service of the late
- 12 Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly; and
- WHEREAS, the late Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly passed away on
- 14 January 5, 2024, in his village of Walung in his beloved state of
- 15 Kosrae, and is survived by his wife Shrue, their children Kilafwa,
- 16 Arthy, Gary, and Wilmina, their ten grandchildren and is preceded
- 17 in death by their son Itchiro; now, therefore,
- 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Third Congress of the Federated
- 19 States of Micronesia, Third Regular Session, 2024, that Congress
- 20 hereby expresses its sincere condolences and sadness to the family
- 21 of the late Honorable Paliknoa K. Welly at his passing on January
- 22 5, 2024; and
