A RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, the late Reverend Father Kenneth J. Urumolug, SJ, was
2 born on February 15, 1965, and passed away on December 18, 2023;

4 WHEREAS, the late Reverend Father Kenneth J. Urumolug, SJ,
5 attended Xavier High School in Chuuk, and continued his education
6 at the University of Guam, Manresa Jesuit Novitiate in Palau,
7 Ateneo de Manila University in the Philippines, and Jesuit School
8 of Theology in Berkeley, California; and

9 WHEREAS, the late Reverend Father Kenneth J. Urumolug, SJ, was
10 ordained into the priesthood on June 15, 2002, at St. Michael
11 Church on Satawal Island, the same church in which he had been
12 baptized; and

13 WHEREAS, the assignments of the late Reverend Father Kenneth J.
14 Urumolug, SJ, during his priesthood included Pastoral Minister at
15 St. Ignatius Church in Yap, Vocational Director at St. Ignatius
16 House of Studies in Guam, Pastor at Xavier High School in Chuuk,
17 Pastor of Queen of Heaven Church in Yap, Pastor at St. Ignatius
18 Parish, Vicar of Yap, Assistant Pastor at Our Lady of Mercy Parish
19 in Pohnpei, Campus Minister at College of Micronesia Pohnpei

1 Campus, Vicar of Pohnpei and Kosrae, and Chancellor for the
2 Diocese of the Caroline Islands; and

3 WHEREAS, the late Reverend Father Kenneth J. Urumolug, SJ, was
4 a very active church official and a highly distinguished and
5 respected member of the community, whose boundless contributions
6 have left a lasting impact on all who knew him; now, therefore,

7 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Third Congress of the Federated
8 States of Micronesia, Third Regular Session, 2024, that the
9 Congress hereby expresses its sincere condolences and sadness to
10 the family of the late Reverend Father Kenneth J. Urumolug, SJ, at




