WHEREAS, throughout his term, United States President Obama loosened restrictions of the embargo, and announced his intent to re-establish diplomatic relations with Cuba; and

WHEREAS, United States President Trump issued a proclamation reversing President Obama's changes and reenforcing restrictions on trade and travel with Cuba; and

WHEREAS, according to the United Nations the economic embargo of the Republic of Cuba has led to trillions in economic damage since its institution; and

WHEREAS, lifting the embargo would relieve the financial burden on Cuba and also have a positive impact on the ability of Cuba to obtain basic medicine and food for its citizens; and WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia established diplomatic relations with the Republic of Cuba on September 9, 2015; now, therefore,
