A BILL FOR AN ACT

To prohibit the labeling of foreign products imported into the Federated States of Micronesia with a name or identification of any sort which falsely suggests manufacture of the product in the Federated States of Micronesia; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Short title. This act is known and may be cited as the
- "Deceptive Labeling of Imports Act."
- Section 2. Definitions.
- (1) "Person" means any individual, corporation, partnership, 4
- 5 association, foreign government, or other entity.
- (2) "Foreign product" means any item or good manufactured, 6
- produced, grown, or assembled outside the Federated States of 7
- Micronesia.
- Section 3. Deceptive labeling of imports prohibited. 9
- (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to import into the 10
- Federated States of Micronesia for sale any foreign product with a 11
- name, mark, symbol, language, or identification of any sort which 12
- falsely suggests manufacture, growth, or assembly of the product in the 13
- Federated States of Micronesia. 14
- (2) The prohibition of this section shall not apply where the 15
- Government of the Federated States of Micronesia or of the States have 16
- expressly authorized the use of any name, mark, symbol, language, or 17
- identification of any sort. 18
- Section 4. Penalties. Any person who violates any provision of
- this act shall be subject to a civil penalty of not more than \$5,000 20
- for each violation. 21

- Section 5. Enforcement. The Attorney General of the Federated 22
- States of Micronesia may bring legal action to enjoin violations of 2.3
 - this act, and for civil penalties. 24
 - Section 6. Effective date. This act shall become law upon 25
