A BILL FOR AN ACT

To create a student revolving loan fund in the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known as the Student
- 2 Revolving Loan Fund Act of 1981.
- 3 Section 2. Creation of the student revolving loan fund. There is
- 4 hereby created a student revolving loan fund of the Federated States of
- 5 Micronesia, herein referred to as the "Student Revolving Loan Fund," the
- 6 purpose of which shall be to provide a revolving fund that will provide
- 7 financial assistance for educational purposes through loans to citizens of
- 8 the Federated States of Micronesia.
- 9 Section 3. Use of the Student Revolving Loan Fund. The Student
- 10 Revolving Loan Fund shall be made available for loans to Federated States
- 11 of Micronesia citizens attending accredited schools above high school
- 12 level within and outside of the Federated States of Micronesia.
- 13 Section 4. Repayment of loans. Repayment of loans and interest
- 14 collected from funds appropriated under Public Laws Nos. 1-22, 1-106, and
- 15 1-125 shall be deposited in the Student Revolving Loan Fund account with
- 16 the Department of Finance of the Federated States of Micronesia and shall
- 17 be made available for loans to qualified and eligible students who are
- 18 citizens of the Federated States of Micronesia. Repayment of loans shall
- 19 be made in accordance with rules and regulations established by the
- 20 Department of Social Services, Federated States of Micronesia and the
- 21 repayment period shall be determined by the Secretary of Social Services
- 22 or his designee.
- 23 Section 5. Eligibility. Loans may be made to students only upon
- 24 fulfill ment of the following requirements:
- 25 (1) Students must be citizens of the Federated States of

- 1 Micronesia;
- 2 (2) Students must show proof of acceptance or enrollment at
- 3 an accredited institution of higher learning;
- 4 (3) Students must support an application for a loan by a
- 5 showing of need; and
- 6 (4) Students must undertake and maintain a full-time academic
- 7 work load.
- 8 Section 6. Policies and procedures. The Secretary of Social Services.
- 9 subject to approval by the President, shall establish policies and
- 10 procedures necessary and appropriate for the effectuation and implementation
- 11 of the provisions of this act. The Secretary of Social Services, subject
- 12 to approval by the President, shall establish the terms and conditions,
- 13 including interest rates, subject to which loans shall be extended to
- 14 students.
- Section 7. Annual report. The Secretary of the Department of
- 16 Social Services shall prepare and submit an annual report on the status
- 17 of the fund prior to the October session of the Congress of the Federated
- 18 States of Micronesia. The report shall include the total amount of money
- 19 in the account, the number of loans made, the amount of repayment collected
- 20 during the fiscal year, and such other information as may be appropriate.
- 21 Section 8. Effective date. This act shall become law upon approval
- 22 by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its

23 becoming law without such approval.
