## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To give effect to the constitutional provision for the external affairs responsibilities of the executive branch of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia; to provide for policies, procedures, and regulations for the implementation thereof; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. General responsibility for external affairs. The
- Department of External Affairs, under the direction of the President,
- is responsible for the conduct of relations between the National
- Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and the State govern-
- ments; for the conduct of relations of the Federated States of Micro-
- nesia with foreign governments; governmental, regional, and interna-
- tional organizations; and quasi-governmental organizations, in ac-
- cordance with applicable laws, treaties, regulations, and orders; for
- advising the President; and for advising other governmental officials
- 10 of policies to be observed toward such other governments and organiza-
- 11 tions.
- Section 2. Definitions. 12
- 13 (1) "External affairs" refers to foreign affairs as defined
- in subsection 3 and in addition refers to the conduct of relations
- 15 between the National Government and the governments of the States of
- 16 the Federated States of Micronesia and the conduct of relations with
- the Government of the United States, its subdivisions, and agencies. 17
- 18 (2) "External economic assistance" refers to aid in the
- 19 nature of money, goods, and/or services provided by a foreign govern-
- 20 ment; governmental, regional, or international organization; or quasi-
- 21 governmental organization.
- 22 (3) "Foreign affairs" refers to matters of policy of the
- Federated States of Micronesia in its relations with foreign governments; 23
- 24 governmental, regional, and international organizations; and quasi-
- governmental organizations.

- (4) "Foreign governments" refer to the duly established 1 and recognized governments of sovereign nation states and the governments of commonwealths, territories, and other not fully 3 sovereign entities. (5) "Quasi-governmental organization" refers to an organization associated with a national government, or an organization representing the interests of several nations, which has the authority to conduct governmental affairs within prescribed limitations, but does not have the authority to obligate the sovereign powers of the nation or nations. 11 Section 3. Duties and responsibilities of the Department of External Affairs. The Department of External Affairs of the Federated 12 States of Micronesia shall have the following duties and responsi-14 bilities: (1) Formulation of foreign affairs policies for approval 15 by the President; 17 (2) Execution of foreign affairs policies of the Federated
- 19 (3) Conduct of foreign affairs for all levels of govern-
- 20 ment within the Federated States of Micronesia in accordance with
- 21 applicable laws, treaties, regulations, and orders;

- of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands; (6) Conduct of trade relations between the Federated 3 States of Micronesia and foreign governments; governmental, regional, and international organizations; and quasi-governmental organizations; (7) Establishment abroad of such liaison and diplomatic offices of the Federated States of Micronesia as may be necessary; Initiation of all formal investigations and requests 8 for external economic assistance and coordination and negotiation of acceptance of all offers of such assistance; and 10 (9) Coordination of missions abroad by National and State 11 Government officials and employees, and communications relating 12 thereto with foreign governments; governmental, regional, and 13 international organizations; and quasi-governmental organizations. 14 Section 4. International agreements. With the exception of 15 treaties which must be ratified by Congress as provided for in the 16 Constitution, the President, in accordance with the ordinary usage 17 of heads of government or heads of state, and without incurring 18
