## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Public Law No. 2-21, as amended by Public Law No. 2-26, to appropriate the sum of \$4,470,150 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia and the sum of \$7,574,654 from the United States Grant Special Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1982, for the operations of the executive branch, legislative branch, National judiciary, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for special programs, contributions, grants, subsidies, and refunds of the National Government during fiscal year 1982; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Sections 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, and 7 of Public Law No. 2-21, as amended by Public Law No. 2-26, are hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Operating expenses of the executive branch. The sum of \$1,120,966, \$1,081,800, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia, and the sum of \$3,796,700, \$4,311,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the United States Grant Special Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1982, for the operations of the executive branch of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1982. The sums appropriated by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

 12          ment of the Federated States of Micronesia during fiscal year 1982.

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1 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the  
2 Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without such approval.
