A BILL FOR AN ACT

To repeal Public Law No. 2-49, to appropriate the sum of \$5,182,906 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia and the sum of \$5,169,497 from the United States Grant Special Fund for the fiscal year. ending September 30, 1983, for the operations of the executive branch, legislative branch, National judiciary, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for special programs, contributions, grants, subsidies, and refunds of the National Government during fiscal year 1983; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.
