A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 7-29 section 3, reducing the size of the Board of Regents of the College of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of Public Law No. 7-29 is hereby amended
2 to read as follows:

3 "Section 3. Board of Regents. There shall be a Board of
4 Regents of the College of Micronesia which shall consist of
5 the following members who shall serve for the following
6 terms:

7 (1) One member from each administrative district of
8 the Trust Territory appointed by the District Administrator,
9 with the advice and consent of the District Legislature, to
10 serve a term of four years, PROVIDED, that the District
11 Administrator shall submit his nomination to the District
12 Legislature for the first member appointed pursuant to
13 this subsection on or before November 10, 1977; PROVIDED
14 FURTHER, that at the first Board meeting the members
15 appointed pursuant to this subsection shall by drawing
16 lots designate three members to serve an initial term of
17 two years;

18 (1) One member each from the Republic of Belau, the
19 Federated States of Micronesia, and the Marshall Islands,
20 appointed by the Chief Executive of that political entity,
21 with the advice and consent of the local legislative body,
22 to serve a term of three years; PROVIDED that at the first
23 Board meeting the members appointed pursuant to this Sub-
24 section shall, by drawing lots, determine a member to serve
25 an initial term of one year, a member to serve an initial

term of two years, and a member to serve an initial term of three years;

(2) Two One members appointed by the High Commissioner with the advice and consent of the Congress of Micronesia to serve a term of four two years, one of whom who is noted in the Trust Territory for his or her accomplishments in the field of economic development and who is not a full time employee of the executive or judicial branch of the Trust Territory Government at the territorial or district level, any of the three Nations mentioned in Section 1 or political subdivisions thereof, and or the other of whom is a nonresident of the Trust Territory but who resides within the Pacific area who is well recognized in the field of education for his or her work with post-secondary institutions of learning; PROVIDED, that the High Commissioner shall submit his nominations to the Congress of Micronesia for the first members appointed pursuant to this subsection on or before November 10, 1977; PROVIDED FURTHER, that the High Commissioner shall designate one of the first two members appointed pursuant to this subsection to serve an initial term of two years; and

(3) The Chairman of the Trust Territory Board of Education, or its successor.

(A) The Chancellor of the College shall serve as an ex officio member of the Board without the right to vote.

1 Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becom-
3 ing law without such approval.
