## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend section 5 of Public Law No. 3-13 to provide for the appointment and congressional advice and consent of State postmasters, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 3-13 is hereby amended to 1 read as follows:

State post offices and postmasters. There shall "Section 5. be a  $post \phi_0$  fice in each of the four States under the supervision of a State postmaster who shall serve under the authority of the Postmaster General and be responsible for the operations of his respective State Post Ooffice. The State postmaster for each State shall be appointed by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, subject to the advice and consent of the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia. An appointment shall be for the term of the appointing President, and each State postmaster shall submit his resignation to the President for his acceptance no later than 30 days after the inauguration of the President or at the time a new nominee for State postmaster of the respective State is confirmed by the Congress, whichever is earlier. President may renominate the same State postmasters, subject to the advice and consent of the Congress." Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without
