CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 3-189, C.D.1,

AN ACT

To further amend sections 5 and 7 of Public Law No. 3-18, as amended by Public Law No. 3-39, to appropriate supplemental funding and to authorize an additional employment position for the Micronesian Maritime Authority, to authorize an additional employment position for the National judiciary of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 3-18, as amended by Public
2	Law No. 3-39, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
3	"Section 5. Operating expenses of agencies of the National
4	Government. The sum of \$1,306,384, or so much thereof as may
5	be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
6	the Federated States of Micronesia, and the sum of \$1,200,000,
7	or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated
8	from the United States Grant Special Fund for the fiscal year
9	ending September 30, 1984, for the operations of independent
10	agencies, commissions, authorities, boards, bureaus, and other
11	organizations of the National Government of the Federated States
12	of Micronesia during fiscal year 1984. The sums appropriated by
13	this section shall be apportioned as follows:
